Permission to Employ Unskilled Foreign Workers in Promoted Projects

In order to alleviate the lack of operational level workers and to control the employment of unskilled foreign workers in promoted projects, and to conform to current situation;

By virtue of Section 11 and Section 18 of the Investment Promotion Act B.E. 2520 (1977), the Office of the Board of Investment, with the approval of the Board of Investment dated November 19, 2018, hereby revokes the Announcement of the Office of the Board of Investment No. Por. 1/2559 dated April 29, 2016 Re: Permission to Employ Unskilled Foreign Workers in Promoted Projects, and announces as follows:

- 1. Promoted projects are allowed to employ legal unskilled foreign workers. Such employment may not necessary be solely for workers working in Thailand under the memorandum of agreement or memorandum of understanding that the Thai government has made with foreign governments.
- 2. Employment of unskilled foreign workers in promoted projects shall conform to related laws and regulations of relevant government agencies.
